| <p><b>1. Red Rock Colombard/Chardonnay, 2007/08 Australia</b></p> <p>This wine exhibits peach, citrus and tropical fruit with integrated oak characters on the nose and palate. The palate is medium-weight with a crisp finish.</p>   | <p>£12.50</p> |
| <p><b>2. Skalli Fortant Sauvignon Blanc, Vin de Pays D'Oc, 2008 France</b></p> <p>A wonderful light, crisp fruit driven Sauvignon Blanc with the freshness and acidity you would expect.</p>   | <p>£12.50</p> |
| <p><b>3. Botter, Pinot Grigio Ca'Lunghetta, IGT, Veneto, 2008 Italy</b></p> <p>This light and refreshing wine is produced in the Venezie region. An elegant bouquet with hints of ripe fruits and flowers, the palate is dry, soft and well-balanced with a full bodied structure of refreshing fruit.</p>   | <p>£13.95</p> |
| <p><b>4. Beaumont Chenin Blanc, Bot River, 2009 South Africa</b></p> <p>Fruit of the best quality is selected from the vineyard sites. Pale in colour with attractive green tinting. On the nose green melon, golden delicious apples and delicate apricot blossom aromas. On the palate, there are fresh green apples and pineapple flavours with a hint of wood spice.</p> | <p>£15.95</p> |
| <p><b>5. Torreón de Paredes Chardonnay Reserva, Valle de Rengo, 2008 Chile</b></p> <p>Made and aged in French oak barrels over eight months. Vivid golden yellow colour. Aromas of banana and ripe pineapple give way to toasty, vanilla flavours on the palate with a subtle, balanced acidity.</p>   | <p>£15.95</p> |
| <p><b>6. Mount Cass Sauvignon Blanc, 2008/09 New Zealand</b></p> <p>There is a plethora of aromas of ripe passion fruit and capsicum flavours, filled out by a luscious creaminess, and followed by an intense backbone of acid. A clean finish leaves notes of gooseberries and tropical fruit.</p>   | <p>£16.95</p> |
| <p><b>7. Gavi di Gavi DOCG Rolona, 2008 Italy</b></p> <p>Amazing quality for a Gavi, with pineapple, pear, floral aromas and hints of vanilla. Full-bodied, with masses of fruit and a medium finish. Delicious.</p>   | <p>£16.95</p> |
| <p><b>8. Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils, 2008 France</b></p> <p>The vines grow on gentle slopes along the perimeter of the Chablis Grand Cru and Premier Cru appellations. Pale gold in colour with slight green tinges and a fruity nose with butter and hazelnut aromas.</p>   | <p>£20.95</p> |
| <p><b>9. Pouilly Fumé, Les Champs, Roger Pabiot, 2008 France</b></p> <p>A complex wine from a classic small Domaine with lovely fresh gooseberry aromas. If you like crisp and dry wines, this is for you.</p>   | <p>£20.95</p> |
| <p><b>10. Sancerre, Jean Marechal, Chavignol, 2008 France</b></p> <p>From vineyards on the prime site of the hill opposite the village of Chavignol, vinified under the watchful eye of Arnaud Bourgeois, this is quintessential Sancerre.</p>   | <p>£20.95</p> |

| <p><b>11. Red Rock Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot, 2007/08 Australia</b><br/>         This wine is produced in the Riverland region of South Australia and is a blend of 70% Cabernet and 30% Merlot. The wine is full of ripe blackcurrant and cherry fruit, complimented by sweet oak.</p>   | <p>£12.50</p> |
| <p><b>12. Skalli Fortant Merlot, Vin de Pays D'Oc, 2008 France</b><br/>         Dark fruits and silky tannins give this wine a noticeable elegance.</p>   | <p>£12.50</p> |
| <p><b>13. Caleo, Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, DOC, Abruzzi, 2008 Italy</b><br/>         This well-known Italian grape variety produces a rich red wine with spicy fruit and firm tannins.</p>   | <p>£13.95</p> |
| <p><b>14. Torreón de Paredes Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Valle de Rengo, 2006/07 Chile</b><br/>         Matured in French oak barrels for 12 months. Deep ruby-red colour. Aromas of red fruit with elegant vanilla and black chocolate nuances. Firm tannins and a long finish.</p>  | <p>£15.95</p> |
| <p><b>15. Viña Real, Rioja Crianza, 2005 Spain</b><br/>         Aged for 12-24 months in American oak casks before bottling, this wine has aromas of morello cherry, raspberries and toasty vanilla. It has a well structured palate with plenty of fine, lingering rich fruit and lively tannins. The finish is elegant and long with well balanced acidity.</p> | <p>£16.95</p> |
| <p><b>16. Château Leon, Premières Cotes de Bordeaux, 2006 France</b><br/>         A delicious young claret, full of soft red fruit with good balance and length. This wine is only lightly filtered to retain the maximum flavour.</p>  | <p>£17.95</p> |
| <p><b>17. Beresford Shiraz, McLaren Vale, 2006/07 Australia</b><br/>         After 18 months in new American oak, this Shiraz delivers luscious dark berries with spicy characters and subtle ground black pepper with a long lingering finish of well-balanced oak and fruit.</p>  | <p>£18.95</p> |
| <p><b>18. Côte de Beaune Villages, Cote de Beaune, 2004/06 France</b><br/>         Red fruits on the nose, notably strawberry and raspberry, and good structure and balance in the mouth. Easy in style with modest intensity that carries through to the finish.</p>   | <p>£21.95</p> |
| <p><b>19. Châteauneuf du Pape, Comte Raimbauld, 2006/07 France</b><br/>         This wine is being produced for earlier drinking and is a big, fruity, attractive wine which is excellent with darker meat and rich sauces.</p>   | <p>£24.95</p> |
| <p><b>20. Viña Real, Rioja, Rosado, 2007/08 Spain (Rôse)</b><br/>         A blend of 80% Tempranillo and 20% Garnacha, the juice is left on the skins until the attractive raspberry colour is achieved. This nose is bursting full of ripe summer fruit and berry aromas. The palate is delicate with good length and a complex finish.</p>                      | <p>£13.95</p> |

| <p><b>21. Botter Prosecco di Valdobbiadene, DOC, NV Italy</b><br/>         Straw shade of yellow reflecting spring rays of sunshine and the flavour is harmoniously balanced with delicate fruity notes, a low acidity and a moderate alcohol content. Prosecco should be consumed when still young to fully appreciate the sparkle (perlage), fragrance and flavour.</p> | <p>£16.95</p> |
| <p><b>22. Domaine Chandon Green Point Brut Vintage, 2004/05 Australia</b><br/>         An outstanding sparkling wine made in Australia by Moët et Chandon. It is elegant and lively an absolute must if you have not tried it.</p>  | <p>£21.95</p> |
| <p><b>23. Cloudy Bay Pelorus, Marlborough, New Zealand</b><br/>         Produced by the traditional method from a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Aged three years on yeast lees, it has a complex, richly flavoured style.</p>   | <p>£23.95</p> |
| <p><b>24. Gonzalez Byass Vilarnau Rosado, Penèdes, NV Spain</b><br/>         Ripe, red fruit flavour of strawberry and raspberry dominate the nose of this Cava. The palate is soft and fresh with a creamy finish.</p>   | <p>£16.95</p> |

| <p><b>25. Moët et Chandon Brut Imperial, NV France</b><br/>         Classic Champagne – blended from a third each of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Matured for at least three years in the bottle which helps give the wine its typical biscuity flavour.</p>                                 | <p>£36.95</p> |
| <p><b>26. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label, NV France</b><br/>         Well-known for both its full-bodied, biscuity style and its consistency, the success of this famous brand continues to grow and grow. A black grape dominated blend, using 70% Pinot Noir and Meunier together with 30% Chardonnay.</p> | <p>£39.95</p> |
